

Technical Guide: AXIS

Release Adjustments:

The AXIS has three points of adjustment for trigger tension, trigger travel, and length from release to strap.

Trigger Travel:

You will need a 5/64 allen key. Trigger travel is adjusted using the trigger travel adjustment pin. Turning it clockwise decreases trigger travel while turning counterclockwise increases trigger travel.

Trigger Tension:

You will need a 5/64 allen key. Trigger tension is adjusted using the screw located on the outside of the index finger hook. Turning the tension adjustment screw clockwise makes the trigger feel heavier to activate, turning it counterclockwise makes it feel lighter. Adjust the screw until you find your desired tension.

Lengthening the release from the wrist strap:

To lengthen the release from the wrist strap you will loosen the two screws located in the strap clamp. When you find the correct length for your hand, retighten the screws in the strap clamp making sure that it is secure and will not slip or move.

Resetting the release:

To reset the release simply pull the thumb trigger fully back and the release will reset due to the return spring in the hook and internal springs.

Some release safety and care tips:

Always draw your bow pointed at a target and NEVER without an arrow on the string. A case of an accidental release could dry fire your bow and damage your equipment. After any release adjustments test the release before drawing your bow Always inspect your release and D loop before shooting. Keep your release dry and free of debris.
